



# CAMP KAITAWA KAYAKS

## SAFETY RULES

1. All students using the kayaks must do so only under the control of adequate adult supervision.
2. All kayaks, paddles and buoyancy vests are to be checked by the supervisor/s of the students, prior to use, to ensure they are safe to use.
3. Every person using a kayak must wear a buoyancy vest.
4. Kayaks are only to be used on Lake Wherowhero. In no circumstances are kayaks to be used on Lake Kaitawa.
5. The red kayak is the rescue craft and must be manned and be on the lake when other kayaks are being used and available for use in emergency situations at all times.
6. All students must be told by their supervisor/s how they are to behave and what safety rules they must follow while using the kayaks. Such rules include:
  - no skylarking while using the kayaks
  - no overloading kayaks with passengers
7. Any damage to a kayak, paddle or vest must be reported to the Camp Manager forthwith. Damaged equipment may be unsafe equipment.
